FAQ's

Q: Why?

A: Helps the DOE and local school systems understand the level of family involvement. It helps understand how parents perceive the success of school-to-home partnerships.

Q: What will be done with the info?

A: The DOE will work collaboratively with Parent to Parent of GA to identify needs and help build better parent-school involvement

Q: Who?

A: The Ga DOE is surveying parents of students with <u>any</u> disability throughout GA.

You've probably heard these terms...

Procedural Safeguards (a.k.a. Parent Rights) offered once per year (or more) —usually at IEP meetings

"I am an **Equal Partner**" (a.k.a. a part of the IEP team)

Do you feel as though your input is valued and a part of the

decision making for the IEP

"Information on **agencies**" (i.e. LMCS, DBHDD, Parent to Parent)

Are you given information on other groups and organizations to support your child?

"School **communicates progress** on IEP goals regularly" (a.k.a. Progress Monitoring)

Do you get regular reports about your child's progress on his/ her IEP goals (i.e. every 9-weeks and/or with report cards)?

Q: How do I complete it?

Q: Why am I being asked about ethnicity and disability?

A: ensures that demographics are adequately represented

Q: Who will see the answers?

A: Answers are <u>confidential</u> and coded by a number, so no identifying information is returned to the local schools. The GA DOE partners with the Parent to Parent of GA organization to conduct this survey.
