

Guardianship

What Is Guardianship, And Who Needs It??

A guardianship is appointed for a "disabled person". A "disabled person" is a person age 18 or over who needs partial or full supervision, protection, and assistance by reason of mental illness. physical illness or injury, developmental disability, or other mental or physical incapacity.

5 Things You Should Know About Guardianship In Georgia....

- The entire guardianship process begins by filing a Petition for Appointment of Guardian/Conservator with the appropriate probate court.
- The individual for whom guardianship is sought will be formally served with the Petition and is required to be represented by an attorney.
- Guardianship proceedings are "adversarial" and relatively time-consuming.
- Guardianship proceedings are quite likely to be contested.
- A competent, experienced guardianship attorney can minimize the stress and expense for you.

The process usually takes about a month, but could take longer.

LANGUAGE ACQUISITION THROUGH MOTOR PLANNING WORKSHOP

FOR CAREGIVERS & EDUCATORS



Anna Shaw Children's Institute Dalton, GA

February 10, 2023 8:30AM-3:00PM

This workshop is open to the community and is an excellent opportunity for caregivers and educators to learn strategies to communicate with non-speaking individuals. LAMP is an augmentative alternative communication (AAC) approach designed to give individuals who are nonverbal or have limited verbal abilities a method of independently expressing themselves through the use of a speech-generating device. There are no cognitive prerequisites for implementing the LAMP approach. Intervention can begin at the cause-and-effect level and systematically build upon the stages of natural language development. This course covers implementation rationale and strategies with an introduction to the LAMP Words for Life language system. The cost of the class is \$139. A discounted rate of \$69.50 is available for students and parents. Seating is limited.

Two 15-minute breaks and a one-hour lunch break will be provided. During the lunch break, participants have the option of eating in the Hamilton Medical Center cafeteria, bringing a lunch, or leaving the campus for lunch.
